



# Photographic & Fine Art Printing

---

Giclée is a term used to refer to archival digital inkjet prints for fine art reproduction. The technology used is similar to desktop inkjet printers but using long lasting papers and pigment-based inks. Our printer uses 12 source colours, resulting in the widest gamut of colours available achieving the best colour rendition. This type of printing is ideal for photographs and art reproduction. The archival quality of the inks and paper means that the prints are stable and light-fast.

We can print onto a variety of papers – cotton, matt, baryta, pearl, metallic gloss, and many more. We can make prints over a metre wide and several metres long. Or we can print the size of a postage stamp, a single copy or several hundred.

## Our process.

At Mount we can print straight from a digital file, or we can achieve a full copy of an original work from scanning and colour work through to the final print run. The more you can do to prepare your print, the more cost-effective the process will be.

Tip: download an image editing programme such as GIMP. It's totally free and you'll be able to make the adjustments you need on it.

## How to prepare your art.

We have a few requirements to print straight from a file. The file needs to be 300dpi or more, sized to the dimensions required for your print.

The file type ideally wants to be a tiff or pdf. We can print from any image file type but be careful about file types such as jpegs as this results in a loss of quality.

Ideally the file will have a bit depth of 16, but 8bit is good.

If you'd like us to scan your work, let us know if you'll be wanting to enlarge the image and we can scan at a higher resolution.

Let us know what size you want the print to be, if you want a border and if so what size, and if you want colour work or other edits to be made. If you're making a copy of an original artwork, its best to bring the artwork in so we can match the digital file as best we can.
